This Agreement takes precedence over all prior written or oral agreements and understandings between 2504967 Ontario Ltd o/a Abrams Auto Transport (hereinafter referred to as "Abrams") and the Owner of the vehicle being transported (hereinafter referred to as "Shipper") and constitutes the entire Agreement between Abrams and the Shipper. This Agreement may not be modified except in writing and when signed by an officer of Abrams.

Services

Abrams will provide open transport of your vehicle from the pick-up location to the destination location as provided by the Shipper. Abrams will make best efforts to accommodate the preferred pick up and delivery dates as provided by the Shipper, however, Abrams does not guarantee such dates. Abrams will not be held liable for any delays in shipping, including but not limited to, delays as a result of mechanical breakdown or border crossing delays. In the event that either the pick up or delivery address is inaccessible by Abrams; such as, but not limited to, municipal bylaws, narrow streets, natural or man-made obstructions, or other such factors; and a tow truck is required, all tow charges will be at the expense of the Shipper.

Fees & Payment

A non-refundable "Booking Fee" of \$150.00 +HST is due and payable at time of booking the transport of the vehicle. The balance of the shipping fee is due and payable upon pick up of the vehicle.

Payment must be made by Visa, Mastercard, Certified Cheque or E-Transfer. We DO NOT accept American Express.

Where extra charges are incurred, they are due and payable in full at time of delivery.

Border Issues

Due to recent security issues, both the United States and Canada Customs and Immigration regulations have become more stringent and border security measures are much tighter. Should the Shipper's vehicle be detained at the border or refused entry for any reason, Abrams will immediately contact the Shipper to resolve the situation to the best of our ability. However, Abrams will not be responsible should Customs or

Immigration determine that the Shipper's vehicle is inadmissible or if the Shipper's documentation is deemed unsatisfactory and the Shipper is denied entry.

In either event, all Customs related charges for wait time, bond fees, and for the storage and/or return of the Shipper's vehicle will be the Shipper's responsibility. Original shipping charges shall be non-refundable. During the normal course of crossing the border, all customs charges including bonds, duties, taxes, after hour charges, and any other charge levied against the Shipper's vehicle shall be the sole responsibility of the Shipper.

A one hour maximum is allotted for border clearances. In the event, our transport is delayed at the border due to any illegal or prohibited items found in the Shipper's vehicle, Abrams reserves the right to charge an hourly rate of \$100.00 per additional hour that Abrams is detained by customs officials. Extra charges will be assessed for services rendered above and beyond these specified terms and conditions.

Condition of Vehicle

Abrams' drivers will complete a visual inspection of the vehicle upon pick up, noting any scratches and/or damage. Please ensure that the vehicle is washed just prior to pick up to aid in the inspection. In the event that the vehicle is not clean and dry enough for an adequate inspection, the Shipper will be required to sign a waiver releasing Abrams of all responsibility for normally visible surface damage regardless of cause. Upon delivery, and prior to signing, the Shipper or their Agent must inspect the vehicle with Abrams' driver and a delivery receipt will be issued. Any damage must be noted on the Bill of Lading, otherwise, the vehicle will be considered as received in good condition without exception.

If the vehicle is inoperable, or becomes inoperable during transport and consequently needs to be pushed to either load or unload, an additional 50% of the quoted rate plus handling charges will be due upon delivery.

Contents of Vehicle

Abrams will not ship any vehicle which contains prohibited items including, but not limited to the following: explosives, guns, ammunition, flammable products, alcoholic beverages, perishables, prescription and non-prescription drugs, jewelry, furs, money, live plants or animals, nor contraband of any type.

The Shipper must ensure all transponders are removed from the vehicle prior to pick up. Abrams is not responsible for any charges accrued during transport if the Shipper decides not to remove them.

Contents of the vehicle are the sole responsibility of the Owner and the Owner hereby releases 2504967 Ontario Ltd o/a Abrams Auto Transport of all liability for monetary relief, damage, loss or other cost of the contents of the vehicle.

Insurance & Claims

All vehicles shipped with Abrams is insured under Abrams Fleet Policy.

All insurance claims must be reported within 24 hours of delivery. The shipper will be responsible for the \$500 deductible for any insurance claim payable prior to commencement of repairs up to \$5000. Claims will not be honoured "after the fact".

Any damages caused by the following will not be insured:

1. Damage caused by leaking fluids;
2. Battery acids;
3. Cooling system anti-freeze solution;
4. Industrial fallout or fallout as a result of Acts of Nature;
5. Damage or loss of loose parts or special equipment not listed on the bill of lading;
6. Damage or loss of loose parts when not properly wrapped and stored so as to prevent loss or damage;
7. Damage caused by freezing of the cooling system or batteries where protection from freezing will be the responsibility of and at the expense of the Shipper;
8. Dead or weak batteries;
9. Damage to radio antennas that are extended more than three inches.

Additionally, the mechanical condition of any vehicle, including exhaust assembly, alignment, suspension and engine tuning shall be the sole responsibility of the Shipper, as such condition of the above items are impossible to determine at the time of pick up. Abrams will not be held liable should any part break in transit during normal handling regardless of cause.

Spare Key Collection

It is the responsibility of the Shipper to ensure collection of their spare key. When the vehicle is delivered, the Shipper must make arrangements for key collection if they are not able to accept the car. If the Shipper chooses to have Abrams mail the key back to them, they will bear the cost for postage.

The Shipper hereby releases 2504967 Ontario-Ltd o/a Abrams Auto Transport of all liability for monetary relief, damages, loss, or other costs related to the spare keys once the vehicle has been delivered.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be received 72 hours prior to pick up of the vehicle, and no further charges will apply except the non-refundable "Booking Fee". In the event that cancellation is made with less than 72 hours' notice, the Shipper will pay the full shipping fee.
